Dear Parents:

Every kindergarten child entering school in the Wadsworth City School District is invited to attend Safety Town! Safety Town is a unique educational experience offered in the summer to students entering kindergarten in the fall of 2019. For 5 days, 2 ½ hours a day, Safety Town participants are taught: walking, bicycle, traffic, home, fire, school bus, car passenger safety and "stranger danger". We are affiliated with National Safety Town and our staff includes a teacher, a police officer, adult supervisors, and many teen volunteers.

The registration fees for Safety Town are:

\$20.00 for students attending Wadsworth City Schools & Sacred Heart **until May 31**

\$25.00 for all registrations received after **May 31, 2019**

You will be able to choose ONE session of Safety Town:

1st week: July 15-19

9:00 am -11:30 am

or

12:45 pm -3:15 pm

2nd week: July 22-July 26

9:00 am -11:30 am

or

12:45 pm -3:15 pm

Class sizes are limited to 60 kids per session and are filled on a first come, first served basis.

We are sorry, but due to space limitations, the invitation to attend Wadsworth Safety Town is extended **FIRST** to students who will be attending Wadsworth City Schools, Sacred Heart School, or are residents of the city of Wadsworth. Students outside the district **MUST** contact the director to obtain permission to attend Wadsworth Safety Town.

Permission will only be granted after June 1 and only if there is room.

Registration for out of district or late registrations will be \$25.00.

Please note:

*Wadsworth Safety Town will be held at **Wadsworth Middle School, 150 Silvercreek Rd.**

*We do have a daily cookie snack. One dozen cookies are provided by each child.

*Please indicate on the online registration form if your child has a food allergy or dietary restrictions.

*We work with your child on learning his/her address and phone number. *The phone number you furnish during the registration process will be the number we teach your child to memorize in case of an emergency.* Please work with your child on your own if there are other numbers you would like him/her to know.

*Safety Town T-shirts are being provided **free of charge** for each child by the City of Wadsworth. Please indicate your child's shirt size on the online registration form.

***We WILL NOT** accept "walk ins" on the first day of Safety Town. Please register early.

The mission of the Wadsworth Safety Town program is to partner with parents, Safety Town Staff and Community Helpers to provide a safety program that will enable all participants an opportunity to learn safety rules and practices needed to enter Kindergarten.

The Wadsworth Safety Town Program incorporates an age-appropriate, interactive curriculum that enables each student to learn safety skills needed as each child prepares to enter school.

It is our belief the Wadsworth Safety Town Program will prepare children to be aware of safety practices in their surrounding environments including home and school.



***How to Register your child ONLINE for Wadsworth Safety Town:
It's secure and easy!!***

1. Go to the Wadsworth City Schools website: www.wadsworth.k12.oh.us
2. Click on "Parent Information" at the top right of the page, then click on "Safety Town" from the options provided.
3. The link to register for Wadsworth Safety Town will be on this page.
4. Registration will be done online. However, payment will be collected on the first day of Safety Town.
5. Simply follow the instructions to register your child on the online form. You may choose the week and time that works best for your family. The capacity for each session is 60 students. Request will be honored in the order that the form was completed. The rest of the form simply asks for standard information needed to register your child.
6. The Teen Volunteer form will be available for interested students after spring break.

Please keep these things in mind when registering your child online for Safety Town:

* You must register with an **actively used email address** that you KNOW you will have access to at a later time. Communication is done solely with email. You will receive an **email confirmation letter** sometime in the end of June. You might also receive follow up emails for various reasons. Paper confirmations will **NOT** be mailed home.

***There is a permission to use child's photograph**" question that must be answered in order to complete your child's registration. Your consent on this question is called an "e-signature" and is considered to be a legal signature.

***Please** be sure to sign your **CHILD'S** name in the *student* section of the registration and **NOT** the parents name! Your child's name tag and graduation information will be wrong if we have the wrong information.

***KinderCare Transportation:** If your child attends KinderCare and needs to be transported to Safety Town by the KinderCare staff, you **MUST** choose **Week 2, Afternoon** on the online registration form! Failure to do this will result in no transportation by the KinderCare staff.

*If it is necessary to work around vacations and babysitting, please be careful in choosing your preference of the time and/or date on the online registration. Also, be sure to register **early** to assure your placement in the session of your choosing. We cannot make changes once a session fills up. If you require a morning session of Safety Town, be sure to register **early!** Morning sessions are always the first to fill up. Once they are filled, we cannot make changes.

***If a session of Safety Town is NOT showing up on the online registration page, it is because it is FULL.** You will have to choose another session.

Unable to use online registration?

We strongly recommend that you register your child online using our online registration links and your own email. It is much easier for us to make changes and to keep track of your information and your child's registration if you do so.
