

2021-2022 New Student Scheduling Dates

New students who have completed enrollment procedures during the summer months should attend one of the following meetings to register for classes:

Friday, August 6 **10:00 am, Wadsworth High School Room 1212**

Monday, August 9 **6:00 pm, Wadsworth High School Room 1212**

Please bring the following items with you:

- **Incoming 9th Graders:** **A copy of your 8th grade report card**
- **Incoming 10th-11th-12th* Graders:** **A copy of your high school transcript****

In order to ensure that you are scheduled into classes that you need to **meet graduation requirements**, we must have a copy of your transcript or most recent report card.

Incoming **12th** graders will not be given senior status until we have a copy of your high school transcript.

If you have an **IEP**, please schedule an appointment with your school counselor. We must have a copy of your current IEP in order to create a schedule. We most likely cannot schedule during the group orientation meetings. If your student has a **504** plan, we will also need a copy.

If you hope to take **any Honors or AP** courses, you need to check the Department Website (English, Science, etc.) located on the WHS homepage to determine the summer reading assignments. We will do our best to schedule these classes. However, due to courses being filled at this point, we cannot guarantee placement until you schedule with a school counselor.

A copy of our Curriculum Guide (policies and course descriptions) is posted on the Guidance web page.

Sacred Heart students previously completed schedule requests and orientation; they do not need to attend.

****Please note:** Schools previously attended often will not release your transcript if you have outstanding fees. Record requests are usually not honored until late August. Please bring a copy with you.
